











On June 8th 1768 the famous German art historian J.J. Winckelmann was brutally murdered in Trieste: now this 18th Century "C.S.I." is re-enacted in "To Die for Four Coins - Winckelmann's last trip". Staged in the magnificent setting of Museum of the Antiquities' Orto Lapidario, one of Trieste's top tourist attractions, open in the evening hours just for us, the show takes visitors on a multimedia stroll with Winckelmann and his mysterious murderer, guided by another famous Trieste citizen, the historian and patron of the arts, Domenico Rossetti. Trieste's most famous crime story will be narrated in English with the aid of specially designed headphones powered by the Silent System technology, in a unique and unforgettable multisensorial mix of voices and sounds, amongst the historical ruins of the park.
